Final Deadline for Full Papers Submission:

The full paper must be submitted by **22 September 2025**, GMT+8. Late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances. The extended deadline allows registered authors for GCBSS 2025 to position their papers for a second or third journal publication opportunity.
