

GCBSS Conference-to-Publication Workflow

Your Step-by-Step Guide to Publishing in Indexed Journals through GCBSS

■ Step 1: Submit Your Abstract

- Submit an extended abstract via the official portal.
- Receive a decision within 10–15 working days.
- Upon acceptance, register and submit your full paper as per the schedule.
- Submit: <http://gcbss.org/Registration.php>

■ Step 2: Register & Present

- Present your accepted paper at the conference (in-person or online).
- Visual presenters may participate remotely via Zoom.
- Receive feedback before or after the event.

■ Step 3: Attend the GCBSS Workshop (Optional but Recommended)

- Workshop Topic: How to Publish in High-Impact ABS & ABDC Journals.
- Gain strategies from guest editors and experienced scholars.
- Sharpen your research and publishing skills.

■ Step 4: Submit Full Paper for Journal Review

- Undergo a double-blind peer review by 2–3 reviewers.
- Receive review reports and a submission kit.
- Journal editors make the final decision (Accept / Revise & Resubmit).

■ Step 5: Journal Production & Publication

- Final editing, proofreading, and formatting handled by GCBSS team.
- Pre-press proof sent to author for confirmation.
- Paper published in indexed journal (CABS, ABDC, WOS, Scopus).
- Publication sponsored by GATR.
